- 1. How long have you lived in the City of Rothsay, and what brought you here?
- 2. Tell us about your personal and/or professional background, how you can use that background to positively impact the Rothsay Community if appointed as a City Council team member.
- 3. Tell us about some of the community activities and/or organizations you've been involved in, and how you can use those experiences on the Rothsay City Council.
- 4. Why are you interested in becoming a member on the Rothsay City Council, and how do you think you would be able to contribute to the discussions and decisions made by the Rothsay City Council?
- 5. How would you ensure that the needs of all citizens are represented on the City Council?
- 6. Explain your understanding of the role of a city council member in promoting economic development?

This appointment position will fulfill the remainder of the Rothsay City Council vacant seat through the end of year 2026. In November of 2026, this seat will be on the ballot again during the regular general election. In submitting this questionnaire, you are expressing interest, and have time available to participate in the council representative requirements. The City Council regularly meets at 7:00pm on the first Wednesday of each month, lasts approximately 2 hours, with additional requirements and special meetings to be completed outside of this time. Starting in March city council meetings will change to the first Monday of the month at 7pm.
